



## SIZE GUIDE

### 1.

The safest way to find your ring size is to get one of your own rings with a simple (not irregular) band (something like a wedding band) and measure its inside diameter. If you do not have something like this, you can use a thin string, which you will then transfer to a ruler to calculate the millimeters, to measure the perimeter of your finger (do not hold it too tight or loose)

### 2.

The millimeters that will result from the measurement of either the diameter of the ring or the perimeter of the finger can be matched to the following chart to find your ring size (European)
